Tomorrow we will be going to Concordia University for a special celebration with all of the Lutheran elementary schools in the metro area. We have an assembly and then special smaller group activities. We will also be eating lunch at the university.

All children **MUST** have a lunch that includes a beverage (juice box) and that is completely disposable. Please put the lunch in a bag, and make sure that your child's name is on the outside of the bag. Include a napkin and, if needed, plastic utensils.

All children **MUST** wear their choir uniforms (Amazing Grace shirt and blue jeans), because we will be going to a nursing home to sing on our way back from the university.

I still need 2 chaperones for tomorrow, if you would like to come, please call me.

On Thursday, we will have a movie day sponsored by the fifth and sixth grade. As a service project, they will be selling snacks during the movies to support a special charity. If you would like your child to be able to purchase snacks (price of snacks are from 5 to 50 cents each), please up to \$3.00 in an envelope marked with your child's name. Please do NOT send more than \$3.00 for a kindergarten student! Snacks will be popcorn, candy, cookies, etc. and juice boxes.

There will be no school on Friday.

# NATIONAL LUTHERAN SCHOOLS WEEK

**March 3 – 8, 2008**

**Monday** – Sports Day! Children will be able to wear a shirt or jersey from their favorite team (local, college, or professional). Children may wear jeans or school uniform pants with the jersey. We will also be having a special chapel service on Monday morning to begin this very special week of celebration.

**Tuesday** – Celebration at Concordia University! All children are asked to wear their choir uniforms on this day. We will not be singing, but the choir uniform is unique to our school, and will show off our school unity well. All students must bring a lunch that includes a beverage and is completely disposable.

**Wednesday** – Color Day! Each class will dress in a different color. Kindergarten's color is green. Children may dress totally in green (or any green clothing he/she has). Clothing items may include hats, belts, socks, tights, shoes, sweaters, T-shirts, shorts, etc. Hair may be colored green, but NO face paint or makeup.

**Thursday** – Pajama and Pizza Day! Children may wear their pajamas to school. Kindergarten students may NOT bring pillows, stuffed animals, slippers, etc. to school on that day. Children should wear socks and sneakers as usual for safety. Sweats or fleece will be acceptable pajama wear also.

As a service project, the fifth and sixth grade classes will be sponsoring movies in the afternoon. They will be selling snack items (candy, popcorn, and juice boxes) during the movies. The money raised from these sales will be for their chosen service project organization.

Next week I will have more details on the type of snacks available. I will ask that kindergarten students bring NO MORE than \$3.00 to spend on that day, and that your child's money be in an envelope with his/her name on the outside.

**Friday** – No School.

Please remember that if your child chooses NOT to participate in a dress-up day, he/she must wear the regular school uniform.
